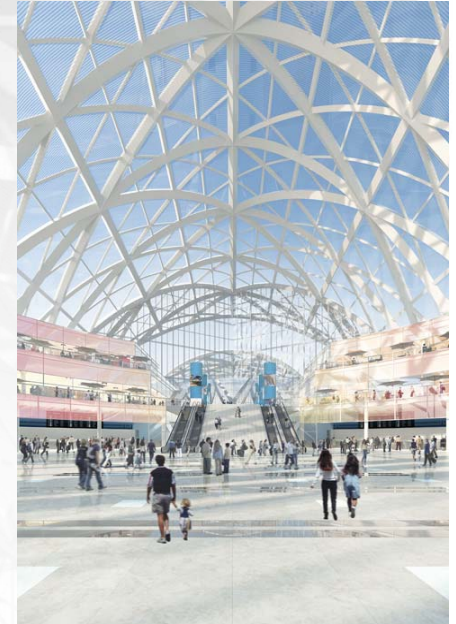

The City of Anaheim, as the lead agency for the California Environmental Quality Act process is issuing a Notice of Availability (NOA) of a project Draft Environmental Impact Report for the Anaheim Regional Transportation Intermodal Center (ARTIC).

ARTIC will be an intermodal transportation facility that will replace the existing Metrolink/Amtrak station currently located south of Katella Avenue and west of the Orange Freeway (SR-57). The proposed ARTIC project is located on an approximately 19 acre site south of Katella Avenue, east of the SR-57 and Douglass Road and west of the Santa Ana River. ARTIC will be a transportation facility where people will seamlessly move between transit services to reach Southern California activity centers and business districts. The station will accommodate passenger arrivals, departures and transfers with supporting retail, restaurants and passenger services within the building.



The City of Anaheim is issuing the NOA to solicit public and agency comments on the Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR). The Draft EIR is to serve as a public disclosure document that informs the Lead Agency, responsible agencies, and the general public of the environmental effects anticipated with the adoption and implementation of ARTIC.
